ENCHANTED ESCAPE

5 Days / 4 Nights Aboard the Galapagos Tribute – Wednesday to Sunday

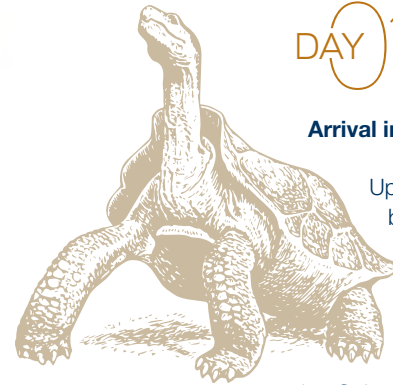
Embark on a refined journey through the heart of the Galapagos, where every moment is crafted for travelers seeking authenticity, comfort, and extraordinary natural encounters. This five-day expedition aboard the Galapagos Tribute reveals a curated selection of the archipelago's most enchanting sites—each offering a distinct window into its geological wonders and iconic wildlife.

Begin among giant tortoises in the lush highlands of Santa Cruz, then stroll the white sands of Mosquera Islet, where sea lions and coastal birds thrive. Explore the surreal terrain of South Plaza, home to vivid groundcover and prehistoric-looking land iguanas, before snorkeling the crystalline waters of Champion Islet or kayaking near Baroness Lookout on Floreana Island. Visit the historical Post Office Bay, then venture to Española Island for breathtaking cliffside views, albatross colonies, and the unforgettable blowhole at Punta Suarez. Conclude your voyage on San Cristobal Island, where conservation and discovery meet at the Interpretation Center—a fitting finale to this unforgettable escape.



DAY 1 Wednesday

Arrival in the Galapagos & Santa Cruz Highlands



Upon arrival at Baltra Airport, you'll be greeted by the Oniric Cruises team and assisted through entry procedures, including registration of your Transit Control Card and payment of the Galapagos National Park fee, if not pre-arranged. Enjoy a brief transfer to the harbor, where the Galapagos Tribute awaits. Meet the captain and crew, settle into your elegant suite, and savor your first gourmet lunch on board.

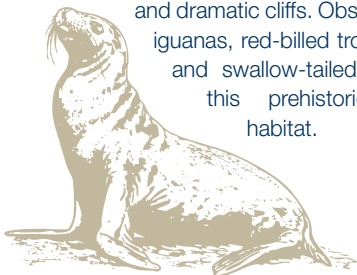
In the afternoon, venture into the lush highlands of Santa Cruz Island, home to wild Galapagos giant tortoises. Walk among these ancient creatures and explore the volcanic landscapes of the El Chato Reserve, where you may also spot native birdlife such as the vermilion flycatcher and Galapagos rail.

DAY 02 Thursday

Mosquera Islet & South Plaza Island

Begin your day on Mosquera Islet, a white coral sandbar between Baltra and North Seymour. Watch sea lions basking along the shore, spot sanderlings and lava gulls, and photograph vivid Sally Lightfoot crabs on black lava rocks. Optional snorkeling offers sightings of reef fish, rays, and white-tipped sharks.

In the afternoon, explore South Plaza, a small but visually stunning island with bright groundcover, prickly pear cacti, and dramatic cliffs. Observe land iguanas, red-billed tropicbirds, and swallow-tailed gulls in this prehistoric-looking habitat.



DAY 03 Friday

Floreana Island: Cormorant Point, Champion Islet, Post Office Bay & Baroness Lookout

Disembark on Floreana at Punta Cormorant to walk from a green olivine beach to a contrasting white coral beach—seasonal nesting grounds for Pacific green sea turtles. Snorkel off nearby Champion Islet, home to tropical fish, sea lions, and possibly the elusive Floreana mockingbird.

After lunch, continue to Post Office Bay, where you can take part in a centuries-old mariner tradition. Then kayak along the shoreline or snorkel in tranquil waters, keeping an eye out for turtles, penguins, and rays. End with a short hike to Baroness Lookout for panoramic coastal views.



DAY 04 Saturday

Española Island: Punta Suarez & Gardner Bay

Arrive at Punta Suarez, one of the archipelago's top wildlife destinations. Encounter blue-footed and Nazca boobies, Española mockingbirds, Galapagos hawks, and, seasonally, the remarkable waved albatross. Follow the trail past lava formations to "El Soplador," a dramatic blowhole where waves explode through a lava tunnel.

In the afternoon, unwind on the white sands of Gardner Bay, where sea lions lounge and turquoise waters invite you to snorkel or kayak among rays, reef sharks, and graceful sea turtles.

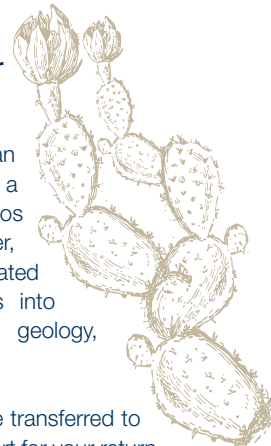


DAY 05 Sunday

San Cristobal: Interpretation Center & Frigatebird Hill

Disembark on San Cristobal Island for a visit to the Galapagos Interpretation Center, where thoughtfully curated exhibits offer insights into the islands' ecology, geology, and conservation.

After the visit, you'll be transferred to the San Cristobal airport for your return flight to mainland Ecuador, bringing to a close your unforgettable journey aboard the Galapagos Tribute.



5D/4N Enchanted Escape - Itinerary Overview

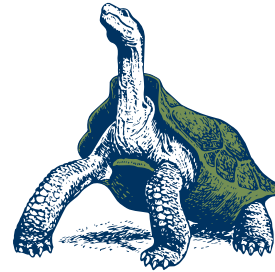

DAY 02 Monday

Santa Fe Island & Black Turtle Cove (Santa Cruz)

Santa Fe Island greets you with its dramatic stands of giant prickly pear cacti, silhouetted against the sea. Hike a trail through this otherworldly landscape in search of Santa Fe land iguanas, Galapagos hawks, and curious sea lions. In Barrington Bay, snorkel in crystalline waters alongside stingrays, turtles, and white-tipped reef sharks—or paddle a kayak along the coastline, discovering lava formations and hidden marine life.

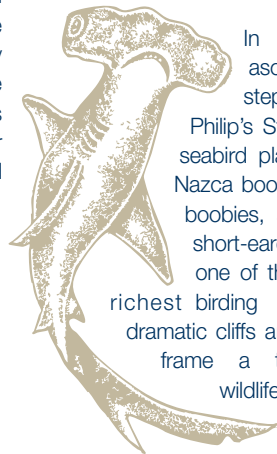
Later, explore Black Turtle Cove by dinghy—a serene mangrove lagoon rich in wildlife. Navigate slowly through still waters as Pacific green turtles, eagle rays, and baby reef sharks glide silently beneath the surface. This protected cove is a vital nursery for marine species and a haven for birdwatchers and photographers.



DAY 03 Tuesday

Darwin Bay & Prince Philip's Steps (Genovesa Island)

Wake to the secluded volcanic walls of Genovesa, a caldera haven in the remote north. At Darwin Bay, walk along a coral sand beach bordered by mangroves, where red-footed boobies nest above, and sea lions rest along the tide line. Spot yellow warblers and finches before taking to the water for a snorkel or kayak session—hammerhead sharks, jacks, and green turtles are often seen here.



In the afternoon, ascend the lava steps at Prince Philip's Steps to reach a seabird plateau alive with Nazca boobies, red-footed boobies, and the elusive short-eared owl. This is one of the archipelago's richest birding sites, where dramatic cliffs and ocean vistas frame a truly cinematic wildlife encounter.

DAY 04 Wednesday

Chinese Hat & Rabida

This morning, visit Chinese Hat, a young volcanic islet with lava fields colonized by pioneer vegetation. Encounter sea lions, marine iguanas, and Galapagos hawks along the trail, then snorkel in clear, protected waters alongside penguins, sea turtles, and rays. The intricate underwater terrain of lava tunnels and coral beds makes this a top snorkeling site.

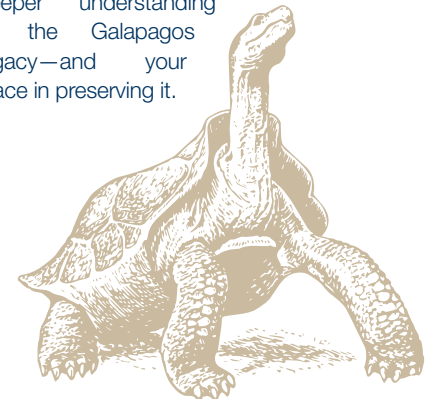
In the afternoon, Rabida Island enchants with its red sand beach and surreal landscape. Brown pelicans nest in nearby mangroves, and American flamingos may be seen feeding in a brackish lagoon inland. Snorkel just offshore to observe parrotfish, rays, and reef sharks, or kayak along the coppery coast past sculpted lava cliffs and hidden caves.



DAY 05 Thursday

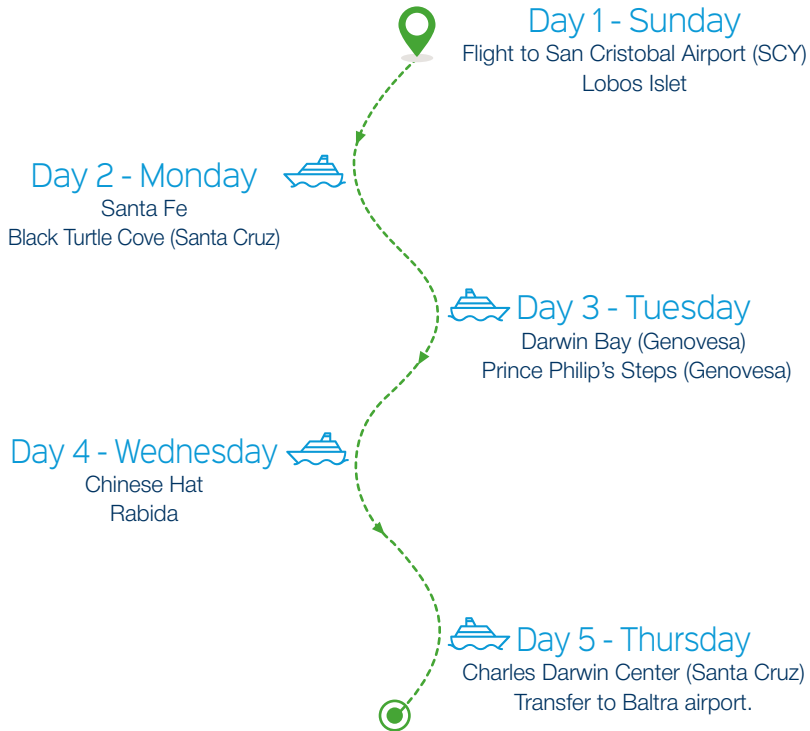
Charles Darwin Research Station (Santa Cruz Island) & Departure

Conclude your journey with a visit to the Charles Darwin Research Station in Puerto Ayora. Stroll through native gardens and observe giant tortoises at various life stages in the breeding center—icons of the Galapagos and vital symbols of ongoing conservation. After your visit, transfer across Santa Cruz Island to Baltra Airport for your return flight, departing with a deeper understanding of the Galapagos legacy—and your place in preserving it.

DARWIN'S ODYSSEY

7 Days / 6 Nights Aboard the Galapagos Tribute - Thursday to Wednesday

Venture into the evolutionary heart of the Galapagos on this extraordinary week-long odyssey—an immersive expedition designed for those who seek deeper meaning in exploration. From the volcanic majesty of Isabela and Fernandina to the remote shores of Bartholomew, Santiago, and Genovesa, this journey traces the path of natural history itself. Experience up-close wildlife encounters, dramatic geological formations, and moments of quiet wonder—each day curated with precision and delivered in effortless luxury aboard the Galapagos Tribute.

Walk among giant tortoises in the highlands of Santa Cruz, hike the vast caldera of Sierra Negra, kayak beside nesting penguins at Tagus Cove, and snorkel with marine iguanas, turtles, and reef sharks in the remote western waters. From flamingo-lined lagoons to iconic Pinnacle Rock, and from lava flows to land iguanas and seabird colonies, this is Darwin's legacy brought vividly to life.

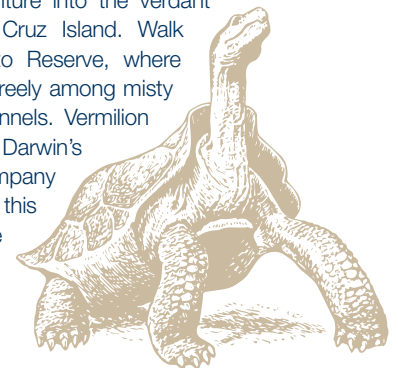


DAY 01 Thursday

Arrival at Baltra Airport & Santa Cruz Highlands

Your adventure begins upon arrival at Baltra Airport, where you'll be greeted by the Oniric Cruises team. After assistance with Galapagos entry formalities, including Transit Control Card registration and the National Park entrance fee (if not pre-arranged), a short transfer brings you to the harbor. Board the Galapagos Tribute and enjoy a warm welcome from the crew, a gourmet lunch, and your first sea views.

In the afternoon, venture into the verdant highlands of Santa Cruz Island. Walk through the El Chato Reserve, where giant tortoises roam freely among misty pastures and lava tunnels. Vermilion flycatchers and Darwin's finches may accompany your stroll through this peaceful, high-altitude ecosystem.



DAY 02 Friday

Isabela Island: Tintoreras, Sierra Negra Volcano & Wetlands

Start your day at Tintoreras Islet—home to marine iguanas, Galapagos penguins, and white-tipped reef sharks resting in shallow crevices.

Later, ascend into the highlands to explore the immense caldera of Sierra Negra Volcano, with views over one of the widest craters in the world. Hike through zones of endemic vegetation and stark lava fields, encountering lava lizards, mockingbirds, and giant Opuntia cacti.

In the afternoon, visit the wetlands near Puerto Villamil. A network of trails and lagoons reveals flamingos, black-necked stilts, and pintail ducks. End the day at the Tortoise Breeding Center, where endangered species are nurtured and protected in various life stages.

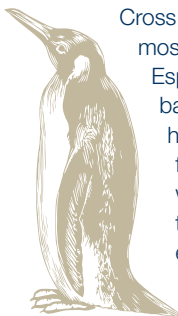


DAY 03 Saturday

Isabela & Fernandina Islands: Moreno Point & Espinoza Point

At Moreno Point on Isabela's western coast, trek across solidified lava fields where brackish lagoons serve as habitats for flamingos, pintail ducks, and marine turtles. Then snorkel in clear waters populated by rays, sea turtles, and vibrant reef fish.

Cross to Fernandina Island—among the most untouched ecosystems on Earth. At Espinoza Point, witness marine iguanas basking by the hundreds, Galapagos hawks soaring above, and the flightless cormorant drying its stubby wings. Snorkeling here offers chances to swim with sea turtles, sea lions, and even penguins beneath the gaze of La Cumbre Volcano.

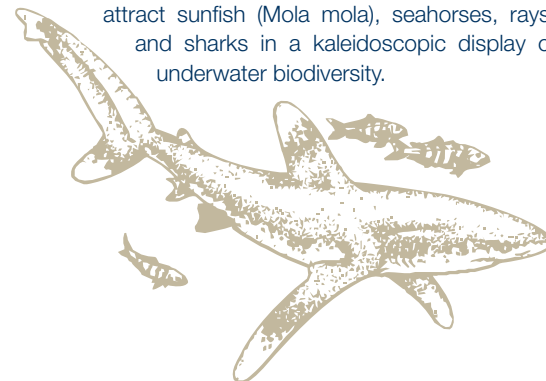


DAY 04 Sunday

Isabela Island: Tagus Cove & Vicente Roca Point

Cruise into historic Tagus Cove, once frequented by whalers and pirates. A scenic trail leads to Darwin Lake, with panoramic views and 19th-century graffiti etched into volcanic walls. Kayak or snorkel along the shoreline, where penguins, cormorants, and marine turtles often appear.

In the afternoon, visit Vicente Roca Point—an eroded volcanic amphitheater alive with seabirds and marine life. Snorkel in deep, nutrient-rich waters that attract sunfish (Mola mola), seahorses, rays, and sharks in a kaleidoscopic display of underwater biodiversity.

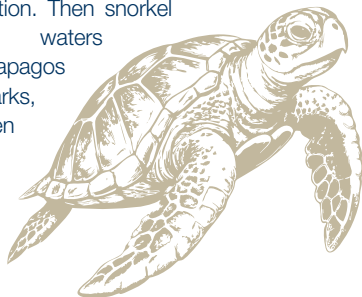


DAY 05 Monday

Bartholomew Island & Sullivan Bay (Santiago)

Climb the summit trail of Bartholomew Island for iconic views over Pinnacle Rock and Santiago Island's black lava fields. Along the way, observe pioneer vegetation like lava cactus reclaiming the young volcanic soil.

In the afternoon, walk the rippled lava terrain of Sullivan Bay—a landscape frozen in time by a 19th-century eruption. Then snorkel in surrounding waters inhabited by Galapagos penguins, reef sharks, and Pacific green turtles.



DAY 06 Tuesday

Santa Cruz & North Seymour Islands: Dragon Hill & Seabird Colonies

Explore Dragon Hill, where land iguanas roam among palo santo trees and cactus thickets. Nearby saltwater lagoons offer sightings of flamingos, herons, and black-necked stilts. From the trail's summit, enjoy panoramic views of the island's rugged coastline.

Later, visit North Seymour Island, one of the most vibrant wildlife sites in the Galapagos. Walk among blue-footed boobies performing courtship dances, male frigatebirds inflating their crimson pouches, and sea lions lounging beside your path. Snorkeling here reveals schools of colorful fish, rays, and reef sharks.

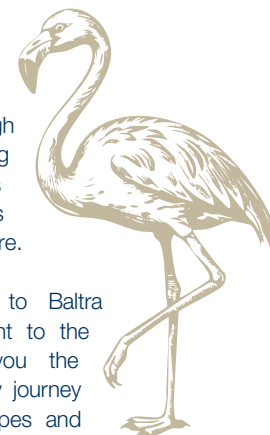


DAY 07 Wednesday

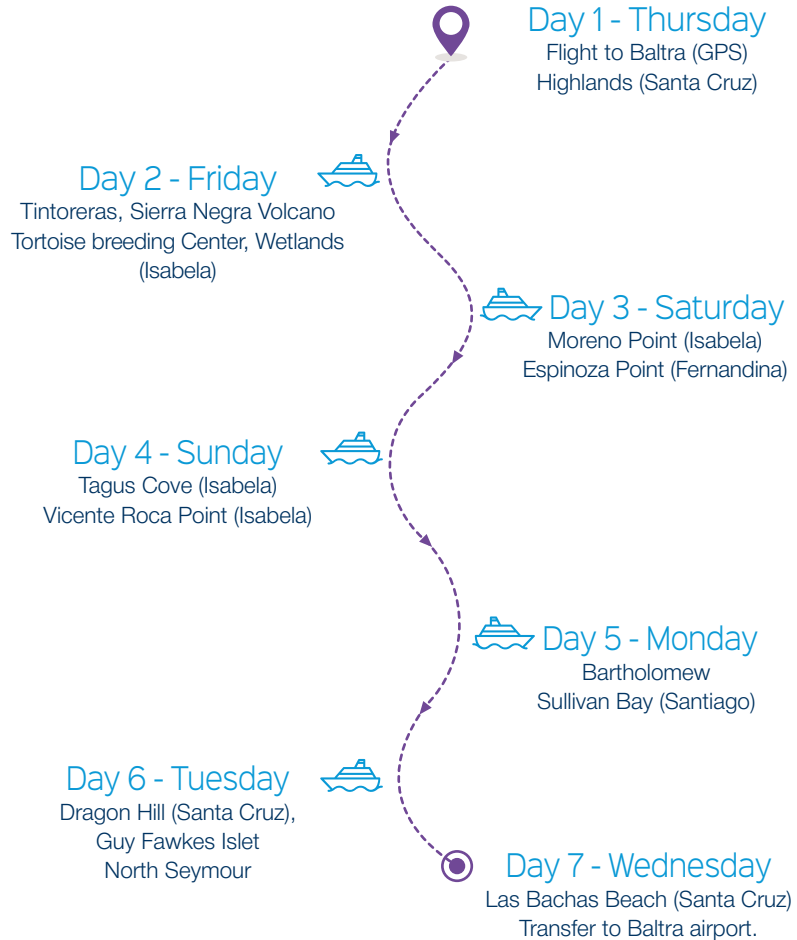
Bachas Beach (Santa Cruz) & Departure from Baltra

Begin your final morning at Bachas Beach, a serene cove where sea turtles nest and flamingos wade through tranquil lagoons. Stroll along white sands past remnants of World War II-era barges now reclaimed by nature.

After your visit, transfer to Baltra Airport for your return flight to the mainland—carrying with you the memory of an extraordinary journey through fire-forged landscapes and thriving life.



7D/6N Darwin's Odyssey - Itinerary Overview



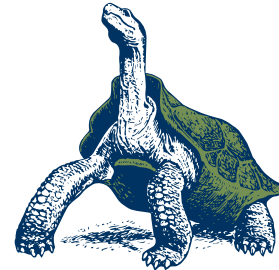

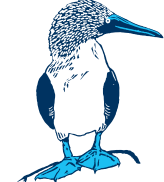

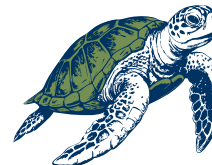
